

MEDICAL DEPARTMENT, LJN DIVISION

HISTORY

Medical services on this Railway were started before 1954 under Avadh Tirhut Railway with Divisional Hospital at GD.

Till the year 1960, Badshahnagar was functioning as a Health Unit under the control of DMO Izzatnagar. Gonda was under the control of DMO Varanasi. In 1960 both the health centres were upgraded to the status of Sub-Divisional Hospitals. At the end of 1960 a new medical district with HQ at Gonda and sub-divisional Hospital at Badshahnagar was formed. Twenty beds each were started at BNZ and GD. Beds were later increased in GD to 70. In 1962 additional Ten beds were added as chest ward in GD.

During divisionalisation of NE Railway in 1969, Badshhnagar hospital was converted into **Divisional Hospital** and Gonda became **sub - divisional hospital**. Health unit at ASH was upgraded to **Polyclinic** in 1983

Following are the stepwise developments in the divisional hospital over the past few years.

1986- two beds ICCU was started in the divisional Hospital BNZ.

1995- USG was started in 1995.

2001- Ophthalmic OT and Ophthalmic PO ward was added .

2002- TMT was started in the divisional hospital.

2004- Upper GI endoscopy was started.

2006- Cataract operation (IOL operation with Phaco).

New Pediatric ward was added.

2007- 2D ECHO & Doppler were started in the divisional hospital.

2008- Pathology services were further augmented with addition of hematoanalyzer and electrolyte analyzer.

2008- Laparoscopic surgery, Plastic Surgery, Urosurgery and spinal surgery has started in the divisional hospital with the help of consultants.

2010-Neuro Surgery, Orthopedic Surgery was started in the divisional hospital with the help of consultants.

-Small part USG and peripheral Doppler started.

2010- 4 bed new ICCU was added and Labour room was improved.

2011- OT was upgraded with the installation of C-Arm.

2012- Coagulation analyzer was added to pathology lab at BNZ.

And **Lock-up dispensaries** - Paliakalan, Khalilabad, Bahraich and Barhni.

 - Monitoring of quality of drinking water in Railway Stations and Railway Colonies.
 - Sanitation at A1,A & B Railway Stations & Colonies.
 - School Health Programme.
 - Health Checkup Camps, Health Education, Multipurpose Health Drives.
- **Implementation of National Health Programmes.**
- **Enforcement of Food Safety & Standards Act.** within Railway premises.
- **Pre-employment and in-service periodical Medical examinations.**
- **Medical certification & Medical board.**

Divisional Hospital is 82 bedded hospital and caters the need of Railway employees (16996) & their families. We provide health care services to RELHS registered Card Holders (5207) and Railway beneficiaries of Northern Railway and other railway employees. We provide OPD & Indoor Services & have following Departments.

1. Emergency
2. Medicine
3. Surgery
4. Ophthalmology
5. Pathology
6. Radiology
7. Dental Unit
8. Physiotherapy Unit.
9. Maternity and Gynecology.

We have Ten Medical Officers in Divisional Hospital , Four in ASH , Seven in GD and Six Medical Officers One each in Health Unit & One ANO with 597 working Paramedical staff & 15 Ministerial staff for rendering our services.

Apart from the above we have -

Honorary Consultants (Case to case basis) in panel - 26

A panel of prominent specialists from the various fields including Orthopedics Surgery, ENT, Gynae, Skin specialist, Plastic surgery, Urology, Neurosurgery exists in the divisional hospital. Specialists are called for the consultation on case to case basis.

Hospital visiting specialists

There are 4 posts of HVS available at divisional hospital BNZ
2 are filled. ENT 2 hrs / day X 4 days/ week, Medicine 2 hrs / day 6 days a week.)
3 posts are available at Sub-divisional hospital GD. All are vacant at present.

Dental Clinics

Part time dental surgeons are available every day - 04 hrs in Divisional Hospital BNZ & 2 hours at sub divisional hospital GD, Dental extraction, root canal treatment and scaling etc is done in these clinics.

We have an **ICCU** & a **Post Operative Unit** (4 bedded each), **Operation Theatre** 02 N0s. (one for General Surgery/Orthopedic Surgery and other for Ophthalmic Surgery) and a **Labour Room**.

Our **ICCU** is equipped with defibrillator, Pulse oxymeter and Multiparamonitors.

Orthopedic surgeries are performed with the help of **C-Arm** in our hospital.

Echocardiography is done by CMS/LJN .

A Modern Laboratory with semi auto analyzer, Electrolyte analysis machine & others are available for pathological investigation.

AC Mortuary is available.

We have enhanced the **Pathology services** by recognizing the renowned pathologies for special investigations on reimbursement basis for the investigations which are not performed in our Lab.

We have arrangement for procurement of **Blood** and its components from local KGMU on reimbursement basis .

We have **MRI & CT Scan** facility from KGMU on reimbursement basis in our hospital.

Round the clock Ambulance services are available in Divisional Hospital BNZ, Sub-divisional Hospital GD . Ambulance service is also available at ASH Polyclinic . Road Mobile Van at MLN on contract basis to cover way side stations.

We have internal arrangement for **Cashless services for life threatening emergencies & critically ill patients** in SGPGI & Vivekanand Hospital.

For providing tertiary care treatment to cardiac patients, **BATRA HOSPITAL & DELHI HEART & LUNG INSTITUTES, NEW DELHI** are recognized on **cashless basis**.

Hospital has facility of **disposal of biomedical waste as per laid down norms.**

- They are trained in First Aid and their services are taken during accidents and health related activities eg. Pulse Polio Programme, Management in Fairs & Festivals etc.

- SJAB volunteers have given undertaking to transport casualties in case of any Railway accident.

Public Health Services

We provide Health Services to the Railway beneficiaries of the Division with ACMS/Health, respective Health Unit I/C, One AHO and Health Inspectors-26 Nos. & 423 Safaiwals. Medical Department is responsible for sanitation management of the following stations:-

LJN,GKP,GD,BST,BNZ,CPA,ASH,LC,MLN,BRK,LKM,STP & LMP. We also manage the sanitation of Railway Colonies of these station.

To ensure the good quality of food & portable water in the Railway premises, our health inspectors collect the samples and sent it to the different laboratories for analysis.
