Introduction

The first Personnel department of Oudh Tirhut Railway was headed by Sri C.S.Khan, Dy.GeneralManager(Personnel) from November, 1946 to 10th April, 1947. After Independence the company and state managed railways were merged with the Indian Railways. With the formation of North Eastern Railway Zone Shri H.D. Awasthi took over as Dy.GM(P) led the department from 14-04-1952 to 05-10-1952. The first Chief Personnel Officer of newly formed North Eastern Railway was Shri H.P.Verma who headed the department from 11-10-1958 to 10-01-1961. He was supported by his able assistant Shri K.D.Devnathan as Dy.Chief Personnel Officer who made his mark as an "Establishment Pundit" from south India. Shri T.V.Madhav, another south Indian, belonging to the first and last batch of Indian Railway Superior Establishment Service (1949, fore-runner of Indian Railway Personnel Service) headed this department as Chief Personnel Officer from 16-05-1977 to 20-03-1980. During his tenure a number of policy circulars and establishment rules were codified which are still referred to. Shri A.S.Gupta Retd. Addl. Member Staff also acted as Chief Personnel Officer from 01-11-1985 to 18-06-1986.
