Please refer to Board's letter of even no. dated 28-02-2014 wherein all the Zonal Railways were advised that on the issue of stepping up of pay, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has granted 'Stay Order' on 07-02-2014. In this connection, it is informed that Hon'ble Supreme Court vide their common orders dated 23-02-2016 have dismissed the SLP(C) 4568-69/2014, 20656/2014, 22931/2014 and 33654/2014. Upon hearing the counsel the Court made the following Order:-

**"Delay condoned in SLP(C) No. 22931/2014
The Special Leave Petitions are dismissed. Interlocutory Application(s) pending, if any, shall stand disposed of accordingly."**

Thereafter, the Board has approved to file a review petition before the Hon'ble Supreme Court. Accordingly, the case was referred to Ministry of Law and Justice. Ld. ASG Sh. P.S.
