The policy guidelines of Cashless Treatment Scheme in Emergency (CTSE), circulated by Rly. Bd. Vide No. 2014/H/28/1/ Smart Card/Part A dated 14.07.2016 was discussed in detail.

This scheme shall work seamlessly on pan-India basis and shall be launched initially in 4 Metro cities, i.e. Delhi Urban Agglomeration (UA) or Delhi NCR, Mumbai (UA), Kolkata (UA) and Chennai (UA) as a pilot scheme for one year.

As a first step, the following action should be taken :-

- This scheme will be extended to all Zonal Railways in due course. Therefore, advance action is required on this Railway right now, so that the scheme can be implemented as soon as the directions are received from Railway Board.
- CMD mentioned that there is no CGHS empanelled hospital in the jurisdiction of NE Railway. Therefore, it is necessary to get the Private hospital recognised following necessary procedure.
- Medical department shall provide list of recognized hospitals on NE Railway to the agency M/s UTIITSL, who are maintaining the website online.
- All the Sr. DPOs should be issued necessary instructions to update database of both retired & serving employees in ARPAN or IPAS as the case may be. This data base will help among others in printing new CTSE cards etc. Finance & Personnel departments shall work in close liaison in this regard.



- This scheme is being piloted by Northern Railway. It is understood that a Joint Procedure Order (JPO) for the smooth implementation of the scheme might have been issued by them. A copy of such JPO if issued by NR may be obtained and a similar JPO should be issued by the NE Railway duly signed by CPO, FA&CAO, CMD and PHOD/CHOD of the concerned department, like - Engg. deptt., who maintain service records of the employees separately.
- A committee of JAG officers consisting of Addl. CMD, Dy.CPO/IR & Dy. FA&CAO/F&G of HQ office are appointed as Nodal officers to implement the CTSE scheme and for authorization of various activities of CTSE scheme.
- All exercise of implementing the CTSE scheme will require additional infrastructure like - space, computers, printers, scanners, associated equipments etc. This will be arranged by concerned DRMs at Divisional level for running the scheme in Health Units, Hospitals and Sr. DPO office and Sr. DFM office etc.
- Concerned departments/Divisions shall take necessary action as brought out above.
