

With a view to extend the social security benefits to eligible un-enrolled employees and to achieve the nation's targets of extending such benefits to working class citizens the Regional EPFO, Gorakhpur & Additional Central Provident Fund Commissioner, New Delhi has started Employees Enrollment Campaign 2017. Subsequently, the Railway Board vide letter under reference directed all the Zonal Railways to provide complete information as called for in EPFO's letter dated 25.04.2017 latest by 20.05.2017 under intimation to Board's office. The same were circulated vide GM(P)'s letter under reference but compliance from the departments is still awaited.

The Central Provident Fund Commissioner, New Delhi convened a meeting with the representative of all Zonal Railways on 29.05.2017 and has again requested that contracting authorities of railway should register themselves and provide the name of contractors on Principal Employer Portal through process flow chart on the EPFO website <http://www.epfindia.gov.in>.

All concerned are advised to register themselves on the "Principal Employer Portal" through "process flow chart" and provide the name of contactors (whether supplying manpower or executing any contract involving manpower) on the EPFO website <http://www.epfindia.gov.in>, and a hard copy to the personnel branch so that the Railway Board may be informed accordingly.
